

## SOCIOL 103: THEORY QUIZ INFORMATION SHEET

*Must be completed between*

*Tuesday 17 August 9am and Monday 24 August 4pm*

This assignment aims to ensure you have a basic understanding of the political theories discussed in class. **You will complete 20 multi-choice questions based on the lectures and readings presented in Weeks 2 and 3.** You have already been given an example of the type of questions asked in lectures and this week in tutorials you will do further revision and talk about quiz strategy.

Given that a week is offered to complete the quiz and you can do it from a computer anywhere in the world, **there will be NO extensions or make-up tests available.**

- All questions are *multi-choice* and will have four possible responses from which you must choose. There is only one correct answer to each question, so make sure to *pick the answer you think is most correct*. Start by eliminating the answer choices you know CANNOT be correct, increasing your chances of selecting the correct answer when you aren't sure.
- You will have *only 30 minutes* for this quiz. So please make sure to only start it when you will have an uninterrupted block of 30 minutes on a stable internet connection. Note the CANVAS site provides a clock to show how much remaining time you have.
- If you are unhappy with your first attempt (e.g. you got interrupted and ran out of time or you realised you had not studied enough) then *you can make a second attempt*. The *highest grade* from the two attempts will be your grade. You will not be given any further attempts.
- *You will NOT be able to see correct answers until the end of the quiz period* (i.e. until after the 24<sup>th</sup> when grades will be calculated), so if you choose to make a second attempt you will not know for sure which questions you got wrong on the first attempt (but further study should make this clear).
- Grades will be calculated automatically by Canvas and released at the end of the quiz period.
- This assignment MUST be completed *individually* and you should NOT collaborate with peers.

### **Here are the instructions for accessing the quiz:**

1. Go to Canvas – on the left hand side click on ‘assignments’ and then choose ‘theory quiz’ (note this may not show as an assignment until the test period begins i.e. 9am Tues 17 August).
2. Click on ‘take the quiz’ only when you are absolutely ready (got enough time, have a quiet space, have your notes out) as this will start the clock running.
3. You do not have to answer questions in order and can scroll back and forth – the list of all 20 question numbers on the right-hand side tells you which ones are still left to answer.
4. Do **NOT** hit the “SUBMIT” button until you are finished answering ALL of the questions (if you really do not know the answer, just take a guess – you have a 25% chance of getting it right!).
5. Click “SUBMIT” to send in your first attempt. If you are unhappy with your knowledge of the theories or got interrupted, make a second attempt but only after you have rechecked the readings and lectures. **KIA KAHA (good luck)!!**
